

Use Walk Test Mode to verify detector and sounder functionality without triggering a full fire alarm. Ideal for maintenance and commissioning checks.

### Steps to Enter Walk Test Mode


#### 1. Access the Test Menu

- Press the **MENU** button on the panel.
- If you're in **Level 2 mode**, highlight **TEST** and press **✓**
- If you're in **Commissioning mode (Level 3)**, press **NEXT MENU** twice → then select **TEST**.



#### 2. Select Zones for Testing

- Under the Test Menu, select **ZONES**.
- A pop-up will ask whether to **enable sounders** for ~10 seconds when a device is triggered.
- Choose your preferred option, then press **✓**



**TIP:** Before testing, check how the sounders are programmed to respond in Test Mode to ensure expected results.

### 3. Add Zones to Walk Test

- Use the arrow  /  buttons to scroll and highlight the **zones** you want to test.
- Press  to activate Walk Test mode for each selected zone.
- *(You can select multiple zones if needed.)*

Zone	Test State	Location
0001	<b>IN TEST</b>	BASEMENT WEST
0002	-	BASEMENT EAST
0008	-	GROUND FLOOR
0009	-	MAIN RECEPTION AREA

**Note:** During Walk Test Mode:

- ⚠ Alarm Verification Function (AVF) and delay features are automatically **disabled**.
- ⚠ Fire Alarm Relays (e.g. to Alarm Signaling Equipment) will **still operate**.

### 4. Begin Testing Devices

- Once activated, the “**IN TEST**” LED will illuminate on the panel.
- Trigger devices (e.g. smoke detectors, MCPs).
- The panel will display “**FIRE**” when a test signal is detected.
- Once the device resets, the panel automatically clears the test condition.

0002	-	BASEMENT EAST
0008	-	GROUND FLOOR
0009	-	MAIN RECEPTION AREA

⚠ If you’re testing more than 40 devices: Exit and re-enter Walk Test Mode after 40 devices have been tested (this is the max per session).

### 5. Exit Walk Test Mode

- When testing is complete, highlight the zones still in Walk Test mode.
- Press  to remove them from test state.

### 6. View Tested Devices (Optional)

- To confirm which devices were tested:
- Go to **VIEW ➔ LOG ➔ ALL EVENTS**.
- Use the  /  arrows to scroll through recent system events.
